

Terms and Conditions for Eligibility for Annual Masters Dissertation Prize

The Society for Reproductive and Infant Psychology is a multi-disciplinary organisation concerned with the psychological, behavioural, medical and social aspects of all areas of reproduction, birth and infancy.

The Society has instituted an annual prize for a research dissertation submitted as a full or partial requirement for a postgraduate degree, including MSc, MPhil, MRes and other similar awards. The subject of the dissertation may be any aspect of reproduction, birth or infancy that is relevant to the aims of the Society.

The prize includes a monetary award (£200), conference fees, conference dinner, one night's accommodation, travel (up to £150), and one year's membership of SRIP.

A condition of the award is that the student **must** present their research at the Annual Conference in the year in which the award is given. This year's conference is in York 12- 13th September 2017.

- Entries should take the form of a 250 word abstract, a 1000 word summary and an electronic copy of the dissertation (pdf format).
- All entries must be typed, and accompanied by a letter from the supervisor of the thesis, drawing attention to its strengths.
- To be eligible for a prize you must have already been awarded your degree. You are therefore able to apply in the year following award. Please also include confirmation of your degree (e.g. copy of certificate).
